

Team Manager Game Day Duties

- Check the Draw for any late changes to time or location and advise the team (usually only an issue in wet weather with ground closures or match locations changed, but always pays to check)
- Encourage your team to arrive 5-10 minutes prior to ensure games are organised and start on time.
- Divide up your team on game day into 2 groups that will play side-by-side simultaneously. The club recommends that children are grouped randomly without preference of skills/abilities.
- Your team will need to lead (referee) one of the games, the opposing team should lead the other game.
- Assign one parent as the timekeeper for the game to keep track of half time and full time.
- Each half will run for 20 minutes with a minimum 5 minute half time break.
- Another parent can be responsible for the substitutions of players. An average sized team of 12 players (6 in each individual game) will need to be substituted approximately every 3 minutes or so.
- One parent to record the overall score for grading purposes only. This will then be entered into the team administration site by the manager after each game.
- Every player needs to be registered in the Play Football system. **If you cannot see them in the team list when you log into the MyClubMate admin system, they are NOT registered and CANNOT play.** Direct them to the Registration page on the website and let your Age Coordinator know.
- Bibs will not be used due to Covid19 this season when playing LFC vs LFC games. One side may turn their shirts inside out as an alternative.
