What's the best age to get braces?

It's natural to want your child to have a beautiful, healthy smile as soon as possible, although sometimes it's more practical to wait for growth and for most of their adult teeth to erupt. There is no definitive 'best' age to undergo orthodontic treatment; it varies from child to child and the issue that's being treated.

Dr Matthew, a specialist orthodontist at our Sponsors, North Shore Orthodontics, explains: 'Most children will not start treatment until 11–14 years of age; however, we recommend a first orthodontic assessment for children between 7–9 years of age. The majority will have a mix of adult and baby teeth by this age, which will help determine if there are any developing problems such as misalignment of the jaws, crowding or overbite issues. Some children benefit greatly from early intervention as we can take advantage of natural growth or prevent damage occurring. Having an early orthodontic assessment is important, as wearing certain appliances may reduce a child's time in braces later and may also make treatment more effective.'

Free Review Program

'Another advantage of screening your child early is that they will be placed in our **Free Review Program**,' Dr Matthew explains, 'After their initial assessment, we like to see children annually for a quick review visit to monitor their growth and development. This way we can make sure their orthodontic treatment starts at the best possible time for them, which gives parents peace of mind. We do not charge for these visits, which is great news for families.'

Modern Braces

Advanced technology and materials are used in modern braces and work more efficiently than in the past; they are much smaller and more comfortable than ever. You'll often see braces jazzed up with colorful elastic modules, to make them fun and fashionable for kids. Alternatively, ceramic braces are tooth-colored and discreet.

Invisible Braces

Any age can be the 'right' age if you want to improve your smile, bite and confidence. More adults are wearing braces because of the aesthetically pleasing options available today, including clear aligners such as the brand Invisalign[™]. These aligners are termed 'invisible braces' due to their subtle appearance. They are transparent in colour and custom-made to fit snugly on your teeth, a bit like a mouthguard.

Dr Matthew says, 'We understand that each person is different and at their initial assessment we like to talk about any concerns they may have and clearly explain their treatment options. It's important that each patient feel confident about their decision and is happy with their choice of treatment plan.'
